The Medical Assessment Unit (M.A.U.) (including Urology conditions) allows patients to be seen and assessed in a timely manner by a Consultant dedicated to the Unit. It has been developed to provide the following:

- Rapid Access to Consultant opinion
- Same day access to tests for patients with acute medical complaints
- Prompt admission arranged to the hospital where necessary

The Medical Insurance Companies do not cover the MAU costs and therefore the following fees are applied:

- **For patients treated and discharged from the MAU:**
The overall fee depends on the type and number of diagnostic tests required but is subject to a minimum fee of €125 and a maximum fee of €495 regardless of the number of tests. The average fee to date has been €255.
- **For patients admitted to the Hospital from the MAU:**
The only cost is an MAU consultation fee of €50.

On an annual basis, patients are recruited to therapeutic and biomarker trials in oncology, which offers patients access to novel treatments.

Bon Secours Hospital Cork is recognised as a European Centre of Excellence for Bariatric Surgery. It is accredited by the International Federation for the Surgical Treatment of Obesity.

Weight loss surgery has been performed successfully at the hospital since 2008. Patients are eligible for Surgery if their weight is greater than 45kg above their ideal weight. If the patient's BMI is 35 -39 with medical co-morbidities they may be eligible for weight loss surgery. Weight loss surgery results in a high cure rate for the following conditions:

- Type 2 Diabetes
- Sleep apnoea
- Infertility (PCOS)
- Stress Incontinence
- High Blood Pressure

Our **Medical Assessment Unit (MAU)** is a modern, seven-bed purpose built facility. Your GP can refer you to our MAU for rapid access to a consultant provided service and for a wide range of complaints. We accept patients over 16 years of age.

You will be seen without delay and any tests required will be organised for you while you are in the MAU.

If admission to the hospital is necessary this will be arranged without delay. If you are sent home, arrangements for any follow up tests or appointments will be made for you. The MAU Consultant will complete a letter for your GP which you should collect at reception before leaving the unit.

COST:

- The initial consultation fee for patients attending the MAU is €125; the average fee is €255 (including various tests) and the maximum amount payable is €495
- However, if you are admitted following MAU treatment all but the initial fee of €50 will be waived
- Your admission to hospital following MAU treatment may be covered by your medical insurance, depending on your plan
- If you are discharged home from our MAU you will be required to pay your bill before leaving
