

DO I NEED A REFERRAL?

You don't need a referral to be seen (with the exception of UVB). If you have a referral letter please bring it, with any relevant test results, eg. MRI, Xray, DEXA.

On your first visit you will be fully assessed, given a diagnosis and a treatment plan will be agreed with you. This will be progressed over your treatment until you are discharged, either with your condition resolved or with referral for further tests.

Physiotherapy is covered by most health insurers. You may be able to claim most or all of the cost back depending on your policy.

Suitable for pre/post-op testing, (eg. ACL & knee replacement) and injury rehabilitation (rotator cuff and hamstring).
